Using *The Reading Workshop* and examples from *Lessons in Comprehension* participants focus on the role of literature in the reading workshop, creating an environment for discussion and learning and developing reading comprehension lessons.

### COURSE GOALS

- Understand reading workshop as the ideal construct for helping students see reading as the active process of making meaning
- Become familiar with the theoretical assumptions that underpin reading workshop and five critical dispositions that students need to be proficient, sophisticated readers
- Learn about Serafini's guiding principles for reading workshop, including the importance of maximizing opportunities for reading in your classroom, managing book choice, creating a responsive classroom with authentic reading and writing experiences, understanding the importance of believing in every child's ability to learn, and becoming a reflective practitioner
- Examine effective learning environments and learn how to optimize space for reading instruction
- Explore tools and strategies for assessment and how to utilize results to inform and guide instruction
